Such processing will always be based on the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of the confidentiality and rights of the persons concerned.

**Categories of data subject to processing.** The Controller shall process the common personal data (personal and contact data) of the Counterparty's legal representatives, employees and collaborators in various capacities, with whom it may come into contact during the performance of the Contract.

**Compulsory or optional nature of the provision of data.** We inform you that, taking into account the purposes of the processing as illustrated above, the provision of data is compulsory and their non-, partial or incorrect provision may result in the contract not being finalised. **Recipients or categories of recipients.** Personal data shall be processed by the Data Controller, and by persons strictly authorised by him.
